Weld Re-9 has completed a reapportionment of our board member boundaries. In short, as the population changes, the boundaries change in order to keep approximately 20% of the population in each of the five districts. With that completed, the board is accepting letters of interest to fill the vacant seat. District E is basically everything North of highway 14 in the town of Ault, including the Conestoga neighborhood. Road Construction....

We have been notified of a road construction project on county road 90, North of the Highland Elementary in Pierce. The project is scheduled to start on September 6th.
